## Wireless Microphones to Cease Operation *in 700 MHz Bandwidth by June 12, 2010*

The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) recently announced a deadline of June 12, 2010, for the cease of operations of all wireless microphones within the 700 MHz band.

The goal is to prevent unlawful interference with public safety entities and commercial users that operate on the 700 MHz band following completion of the Digital Television transition last June and to prevent your customers and clients from receiving interference while using their microphones. If a microphone does not operate on frequencies within the 700 MHz band, no action is required.

Wireless microphones currently operate in a variety of different frequency bands, including many frequencies outside of the 700 MHz band. Only those wireless microphones using the 700 MHz band must cease operating. Some wireless microphones that operate in the 700 MHz band can be successfully retuned to operate in frequencies other than 700 MHz. If the wireless microphone operates only in the 700 MHz frequency band, it will need to be replaced.
